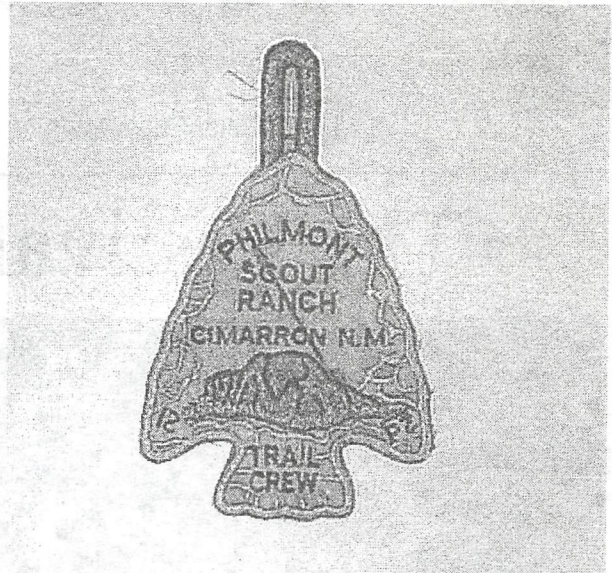

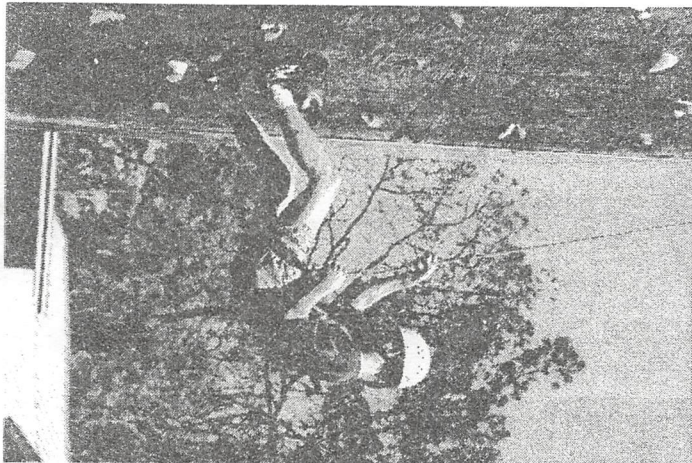

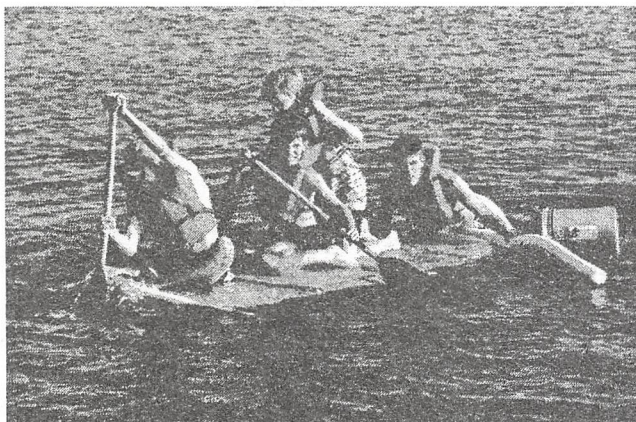

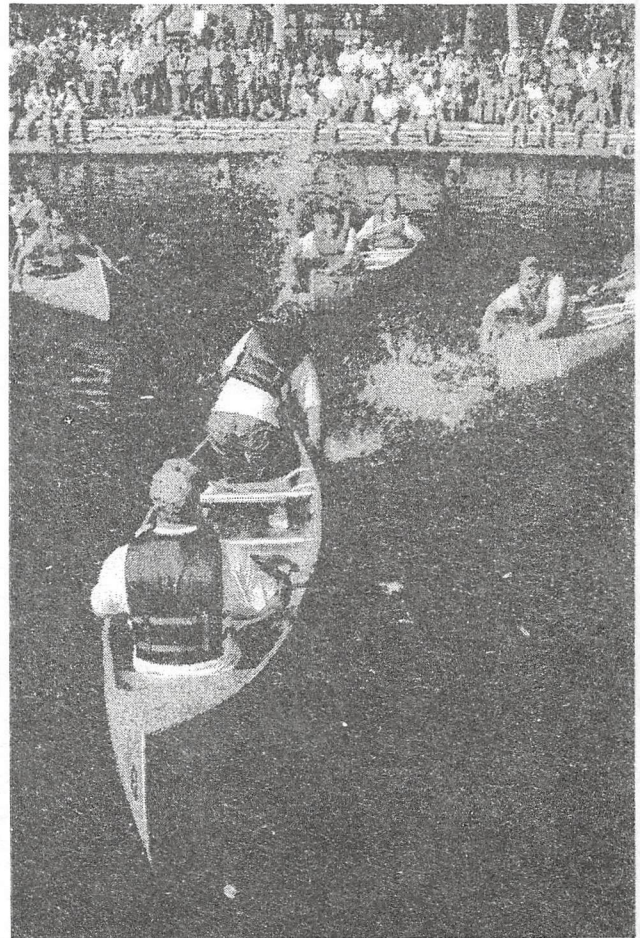

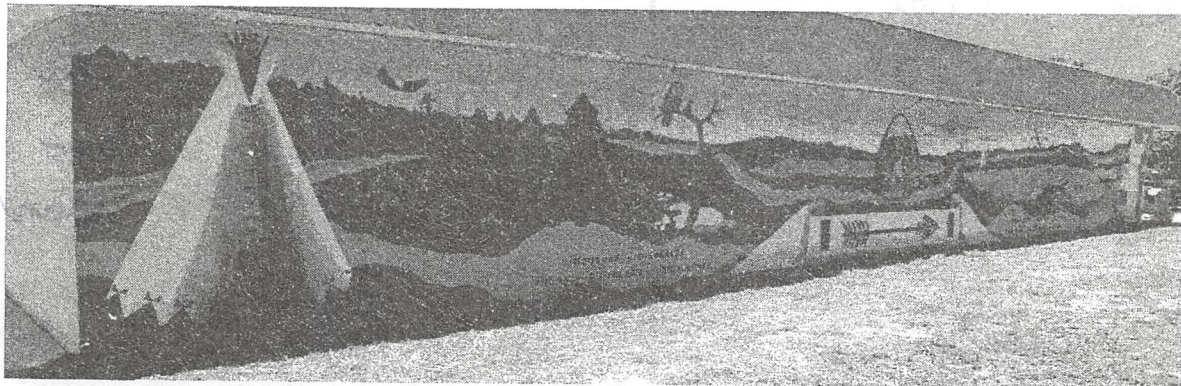
## The Saturday Show
